FAYETTEVILLE VETERANS HOME

At the Fayetteville Veterans Home, we strive to ensure our residents have a positive experience in a comfortable atmosphere. Operating under the direction of the Arkansas Department of Veterans Affairs, we provide a supportive environment and a relaxed setting in which to live. Quality medical care and therapy are the cornerstones of our services in this 108 bed licensed Medicaid/Medicare skilled care nursing facility. In addition, we have been approved and recognized by the Federal Veterans Administration as a qualified state veterans home. A benefit of being a state veterans home, is that we provide RN coverage for all three shifts, 24 hours a day. This is not a requirement for private nursing homes.



CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

- 1) Honorable discharge.
- 2) No criminal record.
- 3) Arkansas veterans receive priority admission, but we do accept out of state veterans.
- 4) Applicants must complete a preadmission application.
- 5) Spouse, surviving spouse and Gold Star parents can apply for admission (Twenty-five percent occupancy can be qualified non-veterans).

All veterans admitted to the Fayetteville Veterans Home will have their name, branch of service and years served engraved on a plaque placed on our Veterans Wall located on the facility grounds.



SERVICES PROVIDED

- Hospice Care
- Respite Care
- Physical, occupational and speech therapy
- RN, LPN, CNA care around the clock
- A Medical Director available
- Daily activities coordinated by a Certified Activities Director
- A Licensed Social Worker
- An Arkansas Department of Veterans Affairs Service Officer who assists all veterans with VA Benefits
- Transportation available
- Personal laundry done at no additional charge
- Security provided 24 hours a day
